

**Overdale Kennel  
Medication Policy**

1. Oral medications are administered free of charge up to four times per day.
2. Oral medications must be accompanied by a means of delivery (cheese, pill pockets, etc). Overdale Kennel staff will not manually force medications.
3. Injection medications are administered at a charge of \$1 per injection. Customer is responsible for disposing of sharps.
4. Prescription medications must be in or accompanied by their original bottles and with their original prescription labels.
5. Prescription medications will only be given to the dog listed on the prescription label.
6. Prescription medications will only be given in the doses listed on the label and on the schedule listed on the label, unless accompanied by written veterinarian instructions.
7. Over-the-counter medications must be in or accompanied by their original bottles.
8. OTC medications will only be given in the doses listed on the bottle label unless accompanied by written veterinarian instructions.
9. OTC medications will not be administered to a dog that has not received proper veterinary attention.
10. Pill boxes are allowed, but all medications inside must be accompanied by original bottles, including original prescription labels for all prescription medications.
11. You may bag medications with your dog's food, but all medications inside must be accompanied by original bottles, including original prescription labels for all prescription medications.
12. Overdale Kennel staff will guarantee delivery of medications except when safety of staff may be compromised by doing so (including but not limited to growling, snapping, snarling, or the staff's ability to read the dog's body language).
